The six antenna towers of the Grimeton World Heritage Site are clearly visible as you approach your destination. From Varberg and Värnamo/Ullared: take road 153. From the E6, take exit 53 from the south or exit 54 from the north. Then follow the brown signs for "Radiostationen Grimeton". You can also take your bike (Världsvandringsleden) or the bus to Grimeton (hallandstrafiken.se).
